



Overnight Packing List

To bring:

T-shirts (6-7)
Long sleeve fishing shirts (5)
Shorts (5-6)
Underwear (10)
Sleepwear (6)
Bathing suits (3-4)
Laundry bag
Rain gear (rain jacket with hood, rain pants)
Water bottle w/ name
Flip flops
Water shoes w/ toes covered
Sneakers/socks
Sunglasses
Hat/visor
Sun masks (2; these will also double as our facemasks when in indoor common spaces)
Toiletries (tooth brush, toothpaste, shampoo, body soap, hand soap)
Bath towels, hand towels
Bug spray
Bedding- linens for twin XL bed, blanket and pillow
Or sleeping bag (could be used in dorm rooms in place of linens)

*Please note there is a \$40 linen package option to have linens, pillow case provided (does NOT include towels or pillow)

*Laundry services are available for campers staying multiple weeks

Optional to bring:

Line clippers (cheap nail clippers are great for cutting all types of fishing line and are safer than knives/scissors)
Fishing rod(s) and gear (the camp has rods/reels for every camper, but your camper is welcome to bring their own fishing equipment as well)
Cell phones/iPads and chargers are okay to bring, but at the camper's risk

Not to bring:

Knives
Coolers
Cash (please do not send your camper with cash; if it is necessary for travel please let us know)
